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**NOTICE** IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING (EGM) OF THE MEMBERS OF **SHREE MARUTINANDAN TUBES LIMITED WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MARCH 23, 2024 AT 11:00 A.M. IST.** THE EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING SHALL BE HELD BY MEANS OF VIDEO CONFERENCING (“VC”) / OTHER AUDIO-VISUAL MEANS (“OAVM”) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RELEVANT CIRCULARS ISSUED BY THE MINISTRY OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS, TO TRANSACT THE FOLLOWING BUSINESS:

### **SPECIAL BUSINESS:**

#### **(1) To Alter Object Clause of Memorandum of Association of the Company:**

To consider and if thought fit, to pass, the following Resolution as an **Special Resolution:**

“**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to the provisions of Section 4, 13 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013(“Act”) and rules made thereunder including any statutory modification(s) or re- enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force and such other approvals, consent, sanction and permission of the appropriate statutory regulators, as may be necessary, the consent of the Members of the Company be and is hereby accorded for amendment in the main object Clause i.e. Clause III (a) of the Memorandum of Association (“MOA”) of the Company by adding the following Clause after Clause 1 in the following manner:

#### **Addition of Clause 2 to the main clause of the Memorandum of Association of the Company:**

2. *To carry on the Business of undertaking fire protection, fire-fighting, safety, security, turnkey jobs and to installing hydrant lines, control panels, smoke detectors, automatic sprinklers, Closed Circuit TVs, fire alarm system for use in industries, ships, oil jetties, oil platforms, buildings, and any other places according to specific requirements of the customers. 2. To carry on the business of manufactures, sellers, importers, exporters, service providers and dealers in the entire range of fire equipments, fire extinguishers, fire hose pipes, hose fittings, fire hydrant valves, couplings, nozzles, suction couplings, adopters, buckets, electrical sirens helmets, breathing equipment, life saving devices and other protective equipment together with parts and accessories thereof and to aid, advise and provide fire protection system for building, offices, industries and other premises.*



**“RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** any Director of the Company be and is hereby authorized to take all the requisite, incidental, consequential steps to implement the above resolution and to perform all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may, in its absolute discretion, deem necessary, any question, query, or doubt that may arise in this regard, and to execute/publish all such notices, deeds, agreements, papers and writings as may be necessary and required for giving effect to this resolution.”

1. In view of Circular No. 14/2020 dated 08<sup>th</sup> April, 2020, Circular No.17/2020 dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs followed by Circular No. 20/2020 dated 05<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 and Circular No. 02/2022 dated 05<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 and Circular No. 10/2022 & 11/2022 dated 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 and Circular No. 09/2023 dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 (“MCA Circulars”) and all other relevant circulars issued from time to time, physical attendance of the Extra Ordinary General Meeting “EGM” venue is not required and EGM will be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio visual means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing EGM through VC/OAVM. The registered office of the Company shall be deemed to be the venue for the EGM.
2. Pursuant to the MCA Circulars read with SEBI Circular dated 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 (“SEBI Circular”), the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this EGM. Hence, the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip including Route Map are not annexed to this Notice. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorized representatives to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM and participate there at and cast their votes through e-voting. Institutional/Corporate Shareholders are required to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPG format) of its Board or governing body resolution/authorisation etc., authorising its representative to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting. The said resolution/ authorization shall be sent to the Company Secretary by email to [cs@shreemarutitubes.com](mailto:cs@shreemarutitubes.com) with a copy marked to [ivote@bigshareonline.com](mailto:ivote@bigshareonline.com) and scrutinizer at [csbhargavvyas@gmail.com](mailto:csbhargavvyas@gmail.com), at least 48 hours before the commencement of EGM. No Route map has been sent along with this Notice of the Meeting as the meeting is held through VC/OAVM.
3. The Members can join the EGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. In terms of applicable provisions, the facility of participation at the EGM through VC/OAVM is available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the EGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
4. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to the Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 relating special business in respect of Item No. 1 of the Notice to be transacted at the EGM is annexed hereto.
5. The attendance of the Members attending the EGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
6. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular, the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the EGM. For this purpose, the Company has made necessary arrangement with Bigshare Services Private Limited for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting



votes by a member using remote e-voting system as well as voting on the day of EGM will be provided by Bigshare Services Private Limited.

7. In line with the MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular, the Notice for calling the EGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at [www.shreemarutitubes.com](http://www.shreemarutitubes.com). The Notice can also be accessed from the websites of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at [www.bseindia.com](http://www.bseindia.com) and the EGM Notice is also available on the website of Bigshare Services Private Limited (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility) i.e. <https://ivote.bigshareonline.com>.
8. EGM is to be convened through VC/OAVM in compliance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular.
9. There being no physical shareholders in the Company, the Register of members and share transfer books of the Company is not required to be closed. Members whose names are recorded in the Register of Members or in the Register of beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on the Cut-off date i.e. March 16, 2024, shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting as well as e-voting system on the date of the EGM. Any recipient of the Notice, who has no voting rights as on the Cut-off date, shall treat this Notice as intimation only.
10. Members holding shares in dematerialised mode are requested to register/update their e-mail addresses with the relevant Depository Participants. 11. The Company has appointed M/s B.S. Vyas & Associates Practising Company Secretary, Ahmedabad to act as the Scrutinizer for conducting the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
12. The members who have cast their vote by remote e-voting prior to EGM may also attend the EGM but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again.

**THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING AND JOINING GENERAL MEETING ARE AS UNDER: -**

1. The remote e-voting period begins on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. and ends on Friday, March 22, 2024 at 5:00 P.M.
2. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled for voting thereafter. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / Beneficial Owners as on Cut-Off Date i.e. March 16, 2024, may cast their vote electronically. The voting right of shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the Cut-Off Date, March 16, 2024.



### Remote e-Voting Instructions for shareholders:

- i. Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- ii. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- iii. In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.
